Parent / Guardian Agreement & Code of Conduct

1. Parents and Guardians are ambassadors of Cruisers Sports and shall maintain high standards of moral and ethical conduct. This includes self control, responsible behaviour, as well as consideration for others' physical and emotional well being, ensuring a safe and harassment-free environment.

6. All Parents or Guardians shall agree that:

 - Parent or Guardian shall not possess or use any illegal drugs.
 - Parent or Guardian shall ensure that Athletes under the age of 19 shall not possess or use alcohol or tobacco in any form during events or at any social activities connected with the event.
 - Obey all provincial and federal laws, on alcohol consumption and illegal substance (drug) and tobacco use. Respect all rules and regulations at competitive or visiting venues and facilities. This includes regulations and guidelines of the clean air policy and ban on smoking.
 - Any damage to hotel rooms or other property shall be assessed to the account of the Parent or Guardian.

A breach of any part of this code of conduct is sufficient grounds for the Parent or Guardian along with their respective athlete to be withdrawn from an event and be sent home at their own expense. Parent and Guardians are subject to the disciplinary policies and procedures of the Cruisers as outlined in the Cruisers Policy and Procedure Manual. Disciplinary action may vary in severity, up to and including expulsion from the Cruisers, at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
